Bonds of Sisterhood – Bonds of Oppression

One interesting point brought out in this article is that of feminists hiring other women for cheap labor, a move meant to satiate the feeling of control. Feminist women are always crying for liberation from the oppression they claim has its instigations from men. The women strive to ensure that women's position in society is elevated and closely aligned to that of men. With the feeling that household chores are central to their oppression, the expectations are that these women may hire men to perform these tasks for them. The notion arises from the need to move towards self-actualization through freedom from drudgery of housework (Romero 97). As such, the society expects that women would be moving in unison towards achieving self-actualization, but in essence, these women step upon their own as they seek for control. According to Romero, domestic service is in contradiction to the feminist approach that called for involvement of women outside their homes but failed to hold men responsible for such tasks (98). The most interesting aspect in this point by Romero is that the upper class women or feminists regard having domestic laborers as progress.

The approach by women in searching for feminist power ends up in overly stamping upon the same doctrines they hold at heart. The idiosyncrasies by feminists are further visible with their oppression of domestic workers through poor pays and unfulfilled contracts. By doing so, they further tread upon their own ideologies of the need for an elevated woman. More so, the

occupation of this position by a domestic worker shows how much demeaning women are to themselves. Such propositions are in order, since employers hire domestic workers to perform some tasks that they feel are demeaning (Romero100). The issue of women seeking other women to perform domestic tasks for them is not a positive shift in the ideology of feminism but rather a replacement of individuals taking up the burden for others.
